Dear Tots-N-Us School-Aged Families,

Tots-N-Us is launching an opportunity for your child to engage in Remote/online learning. We are implementing a, Bring Your Own Device Policy for the upcoming school year for those who need to access Remote learning and complete assignments for the 2020/2021 school year. Students will be able to bring their own laptop or tablet to use for educational purposes. As we implement this, there are a few important details and guidelines that we need to address to ensure the safety and security for all.

Educational Activities

Student devices will be used to access resources and complete assignments as per your child's elementary school. Educational activities will be completed based on assignments assigned by your child's primary school teacher(s).

Safe and Secure

To maintain a safe and secure learning environment, a filtered Internet connection will be provided for students. Students will only be able to use their device under the direct supervision of the supervising teacher. Any unauthorized use can result in technology privileges being revoked.

Responsibility

Students are solely responsible for their device. They must bring it fully charged to school **with headphones and chargers**. Tots-N-Us is not liable for loss, damage, misuse, or theft of personal items.

Technical Support

Your child must be familiar with how to use their device. Teachers will supervise during their time on their devices. If technical support is needed, the supervising teacher will do their best to provide assistance. Tots-N-Us does not guarantee connectivity or the quality of the connection with personal devices.

Printing & Curriculum Materials

Curriculum materials and resources are to be provided by your child's school district. Please be sure your child arrives to Tots-N-Us with all materials essential for completing their schoolwork. If your child needs supplemental materials, printed resources, or any physical materials related to academic curriculum, they are to be provided by the child's school district. It is not the responsibility of Tots-N-Us to provide these curriculum-based materials. When your child is not working on academic material, Tots-N-Us is excited to have engaging activities throughout the day!
